A Roman inscription on a tombstone preserved in Morella in the year 212 for the salvation of the Emperor Caracalla, which was erected by the res publica Leserensis, gives name to this Roman city.

La Moleta dels Frares is a site that was occupied from the Bronze Age to the Andalusian period, located 2 km from the town of Forcall, in the region of Els Ports. It sits on a small millstone located on the river Cantavieja, at an altitude of about 895 m, surrounded by rocky escarpments that provide it with a natural defense.

The archaeological works have allowed to document in its totality an entire domus. It is a simple, compact house with a rectangular floor plan, 120 m.
